

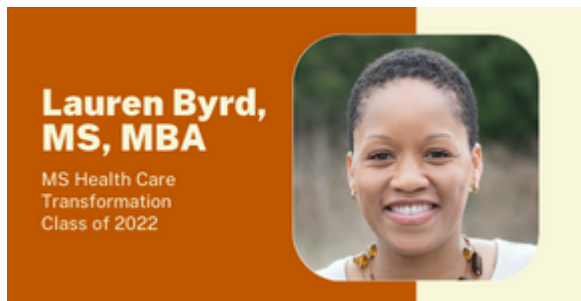


Congratulations Class of 2022!

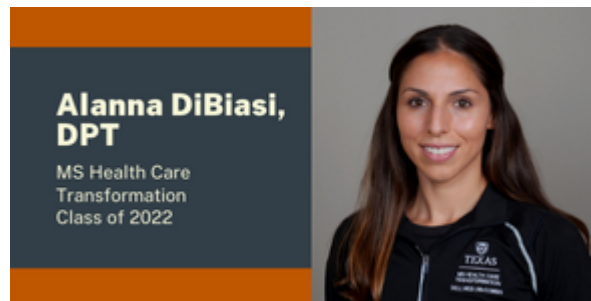
They have worked extremely hard this year, and we are excited to see what they will do in the future.
